## **COUNCIL TOWER OF SIBIU**

**(TURNUL  
SFATULUI  
DIN SIBIU)**

These towers two archway makes the connection between the big market and the small market. Archaeologists claim that the tower was built at the same time as the second defensive wall, between 1224-1241. You can get inside the tower through a small door, from here a spiral staircase leads to the upper storeys.



Khan el-Khalili is a major souk in the Islamic district of Cairo. The bazaar district is one of Cairo's main attractions for tourists and Egyptians alike.

## ROMAN EMPEROR HOTEL

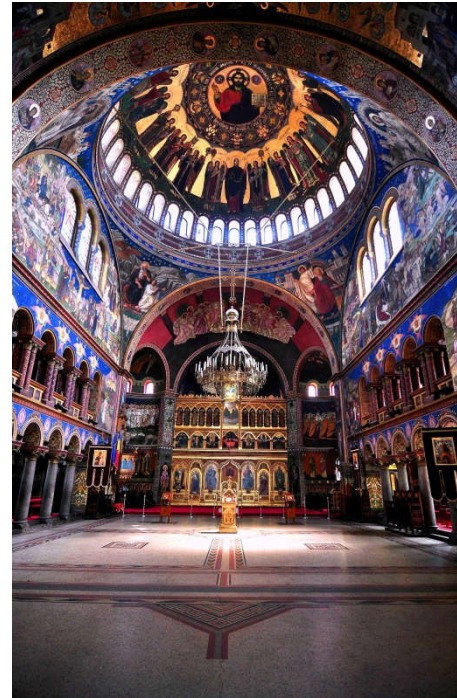
Dating back to the sixteenth century Roman emperor's hotel impresses with its sophisticated architecture and elegant interiors. It is located in the historic center of Sibiu.

Built between 1902-1906, Sibiu enormous Orthodox Cathedral was, surprisingly, designed by two Budapest-based Hungarian architects. The ornate exterior with two colours of pressed stone set in horizontal stripes is complemented by a wonderful interior, possibly the most extravagantly decorated of any church in Romania.

## LARGE SQUARE SIBIU

The square exists since 1366, when the third fortification belt was completed.

It was mentioned in 1408 by Mathias Baldi who bought and repaired a stone house in the Large Square.

During the Middle Ages, the square was the stage of the most important events of the city's daily life, such as public gatherings but also executions.

Tahrir Square also known as "Martyr Square", is a major public town square in Downtown Cairo, Egypt. The square has been the location and focus for political demonstrations in Cairo, most notably those that led to the 2011 Egyptian revolution and the resignation of President Hosni Mubarak.





## ASTRA PARK SIBIU

The park is situated in the heart of the city.

The park hosts 9 busts of the most important Romanian personalities grouped around the association with the same name: Gheorghe Baritiu, Badea Cartan, Timotei Cipariu, Octavian Goga, Gheorghe Lazăr, Andrei Mureșanu, Andrei Saguna, Ioan Slavici and Emanuil Gojdu.

The Brukenthal National Museums is a museum, erected in the late 18th century in Sibiu, Transylvania, Romania, housed in the palace of Samuel von Brukenthal — who was Habsburg governor of Transylvania and who established its first collections around 1790. The collections were officially opened to the public in 1817, making it the oldest institution of its kind in Romania.

Al Azhar Square is a mosque in Islamic Cairo in Egypt. Al-Mu'izz li-Din Allah of the Fatimid Caliphate commissioned its construction for the newly established capital city in 970.

This complex of ancient monuments includes the three pyramid complexes known as the Great Pyramids, the massive sculpture known as the Great Sphinx, several cemeteries, a workers' village and an industrial complex.
